Open Access - continuous, immediate, unrestricted and free online access to full-length texts of scientific publications (most often articles) without any limitations

TA CR requirements:

- Article 14.4 KAPPA Terms and Conditions
- Open Access to all J-type results - peer-reviewed scientific publications
- Ensure that Beneficiaries or the authors retain sufficient intellectual property rights to comply with the Open Access requirements

2 steps:

- 1) **Upload the result to a repository:** machine-readable, final and reviewed version of the article in one of the open repositories by the day of the article publication at the latest.
- 2) **Ensure open access to results:**
 - a) **Green open access** - No later than 6 months (12 months in the case of articles on social sciences or humanities) from the publication the beneficiary discloses the text in full in an open repository.
 - b) **Gold open access** - Immediately publishing an article in one of the open periodicals.

For ensuring step 1 and 2.a it is possible to search in the international database OpenDoar, the European Multidisciplinary Repository – Zenodo, registry of research data repositories re3data or a catalogue of databases FAIRsharing.

For ensuring step 2.b it is possible to search the citation indexes of Web of Science or Scopus or in the international database Directory of Open Access Journals – DOAJ.



TA CR recommendations:

- not to transfer copyright to the results but only to grant the publisher the necessary licenses for publishing
- to publish the results under public licenses
- to verify that the selected periodical does not have the nature of a predatory journal
- to take into account the quality of relevant journals when choosing

Open access to the digital research data generated in the project shall be ensured in line with the principle '**as open as possible, as closed as necessary**'.



The **Data Management Plan** describes the management cycle for the data that Beneficiaries collect, process, or generate within a project.

The Data Management Plan should include:

- what data will be collected, processed or generated
- which methodologies and standards will be used
- whether the data will be shared or published under open access and how the data will be managed and shared
- including the period after the end of the project

TA CR requirements and recommendations:

- Article 4.2(I) KAPPA Terms and Conditions
- submit via a data box
- requirement: 1st DMP - six months from the start date of the project
recommendation: annual update

Using DESCA template for the Partnership Agreement

To access, mine, exploit, reproduce and disseminate:

- the data, including associated metadata, needed to validate the results presented in scientific publications
- other data, including associated metadata, as specified in the data management plan

Exceptions:

Legitimate interests of the Parties, project objectives, any other constraints (such as data protection rules, security rules or intellectual property rights).

All Parties shall establish a Data Management Plan and shall ensure a responsible management of research data in line with the principles **'Findability', 'Accessibility', 'Interoperability' and 'Reusability' (FAIR)**.

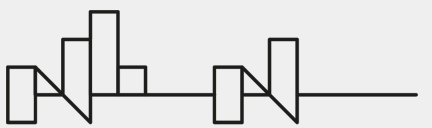
